


the other has acted, either by omission or commission, in an objectionable manner (the "alleged objectionable conduct"). They have also each alleged that the joint pre-trial order ("JPTO") that they submitted to the Court April 1, 2009, is deficient in ways that will make trial more difficult (the "alleged JPTO deficiencies").

No later than 5:00 PM on Friday May 8, 2009, counsel for Plaintiffs and Defendants shall each fax to the Court (805-7900) the following information:

- (1) what they deem to be the five most egregious instances of their opposing counsel's alleged objectionable conduct; and
- (2) what they deem to be the five most important alleged JPTO deficiencies.
