WHEREAS, BL&L and Keefe Bartels believe it is appropriate, for all the reasons identified in Keefe Bartels's Brief in Support of Motion to Seal Materials, to seal any and all filings related to the Motion for Fees and Costs, including not only the documents specifically identified in the Motion to Seal (Docket Nos. 460, 461, and 462), but also any materials filed in response to the Motion for Fees and Costs (due on February 7, 2008) and any materials filed in reply to that motion (due on February 14, 2008); and

WHEREAS, BL&L and Keefe Bartels do not believe oral argument related to the Motion to Seal is necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Lead Plaintiff's Memorandum in Opposition to Motion for Award of Attorneys' Fees and Costs (dated February 7, 2008), and the Declaration of Stanley D. Bernstein (executed on February 7, 2008), both of which are to be filed on February 7, 2008, are ordered to be sealed.
