## **Gulf to Obtain General Atomic**

The Gulf Oil Corporation will become full owner of the General Atomic Company, a partnership of Gulf and Royal Dutch/Shell Group's Scallop Nuclear Inc., under a tentative agreement between the partners, General Atomic said.

Scallop will take over ownership of a large tract of land owned by General Atomic adjacent to its San Diego headquarters, a Gulf spokesman said. The effective date of the changes is Jan. 1, General Atomic said.

The operations that Gulf will take over include Scallop's hightemperature, gas-cooled reactor program, its fusion program and the special products division.
